It is important to prepare for this so you can tell the judges about yourself.

Your aspirations and what is important in your life. It is not a beauty pageant.

- To assist all entrants through their participation to develop strong communication and leadership qualities.
- Enable the entrant to gain greater proficiency in their chosen field and also to develop entrants' stature and reputation in that chosen field.

Conditions of Entry:

- Entrants must be aged between 20 & 30 years as at the 1<sup>st</sup> of May 2020 and must reside in Victoria.
- Entrants may be involved in a rural or agricultural based industry or be associated with a Show Society/Field Day but do not necessarily need to reside in a rural community.
- Entrants must demonstrate an active involvement and desire to be involved in the future and improvement of their local community and/or Show.

- Provide information indicating your reason for applying for entry together with a curriculum vitae, indicating work experience, community participation, agricultural and Show involvement if applicable.
