Conditions of entry:

- Entrants must be aged between 16 & 19 years on the day of their show
- Entrants to demonstrate an active involvement and a desire to be involved in the future and improvement of their local community and Show Society.
- You will be invited by the Show Society to come along for judging by two judges. This will consist of a semi-formal interview in which you will be asked questions about yourself and assessed against the judging criteria.

Aims of the Rural Ambassador Award:

- To assist all entrants through their participation to develop strong communication and leadership qualities.
- Enable the entrant to gain greater proficiency in their chosen field and also to develop entrants' stature and reputation in that chosen field.

Conditions of Entry:

- Entrants must be aged between 20 & 30 years as at the 1st of May 2024 and must reside in Victoria.
- Entrants may be involved in a rural or agriculture based industry or be associated with a Show Society/Field Day but do not necessarily need to reside in a rural community.
- Entrants must demonstrate an active involvement and desire to be involved in the future and improvement of their local community and or Show.
